NAACP MISSION

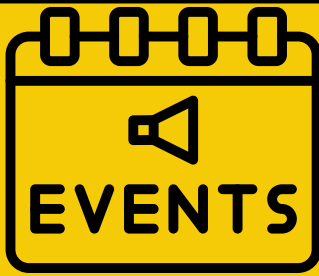
